Prizes

The competitor returning the lowest scratch medal score over 18 holes will hold the Trophy for one Year.

Additional prizes will be awarded for:- 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th & 6th place gross.

Conditions

- The competition will be played over 18 holes of medal play, in accordance with the Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of the Club. The decision of the Competition Committee will be final.
- The competition is open to amateur golfers who are members of an affiliated golf club, with a handicap not exceeding 5 under the current Scratch Score and handicapping scheme of C.O.N.G.U. The competition will be a qualifying Competition for handicapping purposes.
- Entries will be limited to 90, in the event of this limit being exceeded, there will be a ballot of higher handicaps for places, with a reserve list provided. The Competition Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without reason. **ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY NO LATER THAN THURSDAY 18th MARCH** on the completed entry form below, with a cheque for the Entry Fee of **£40.00** made payable to **Brocket Hall International Limited**. Please note that cheques will not be cashed until after the draw has been made.
- In the event of a tie for the trophy there will be a sudden death play-off starting from the first tee.
- All players must use a ball on the current list of R & A approved balls, not less than 1.68".
- Practice rounds are permitted weekdays after 1.00pm at £30.00 each and should be booked through the golf shop on 01707 368739. All guests must sign the Visitors Book on arrival.**
- The Entry Fee of £40.00 includes tea and coffee on arrival and buffet lunch on return to the Clubhouse, prize giving will be at 4.00pm approx.
- Competitors are required to report to the relevant starting tees at least 5 minutes prior to their starting time, details of which will be posted to the address on the entry form as soon as possible after the closing date – Thursday 18th March.
The Competition Committee reserves the right to amend any starting times accordingly.
- Competitors are informed that smart casual dress is in order all day and the **use of mobile phones is strictly forbidden within the Clubhouse and on the course.**
- Finally, in the interest of all parties, competitors are expected to complete the full 18 holes, the estimated time for the round is 4 hours 10 minutes, except in exceptional circumstances where this is not possible.
