GENERAL CONDITIONS RELATING TO THE CHAMPIONSHIP

1. All Championships shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf of the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and the Local Rules as shall be approved by Fairhaven Golf Club.
2. All competitors must be of Amateur Status as defined by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews.
3. In all cases where individual entry is made by means of an official entry form:
 - a) All entries must be made on the appropriate official entry form and must be received by the Secretary of Fairhaven Golf Club on or before the stipulated closing date for entries. All such entry forms must be accompanied by the stipulated entry fee and a return stamped addressed envelope for the draw to be sent. (Cheques made payable to Fairhaven Golf Club)
 - b) Facsimiles of entry forms will be accepted provided the form has been fully completed, signed personally by the entrant and both the facsimile and the stipulated entry fee are received before 5pm on the stipulated closing date.
 - c) No entry fee will be refunded unless intimation of scratching is received before the closing date for entries except for any entrant who may be balloted out and who does not subsequently compete.
 - d) All entries shall be subject to the approval of the Championship Committee which reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry without giving reason for its decision, which shall be final.
 - e) The Championship Committee reserves the right to accept late entries.
4. The Championship Committee reserves the right to fix and/or alter starting times. Any competitor who is not present on their starting tee at his/her appointed starting time shall be disqualified, except that the note to Rule 6-3 of the Rules of Golf shall apply.
5. If it becomes impossible to complete the Championship in accordance with the Conditions thereof because of adverse weather conditions or other circumstances which, in the opinion of the Championship Committee, make it impossible or impractical to do so, the Championship Committee shall be empowered to vary such Conditions to the extent necessary to achieve a result within the time available.
6. All competitors will be required to play with golf balls which are on the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews list of Confirming Golf Balls current at the date of the Championship. PENALTY for breach of condition: Disqualification
7. Competitors will not be permitted to ride on motorised buggy carts without permission of the Championship Committee. PENALTY for breach of condition: 2 shots penalty, maximum 4.
8. A competitor shall not knowingly make use of any drug to enhance his/her performance. Attention is drawn to the list of prohibited drugs issued by Sport England. Any competitor infringing this condition or, if asked to do so, refusing to take a test, may be disqualified.
9. All disputes shall be settled by the Championship Committee (three to form a quorum) whose decision shall be final.
10. All ties, except those of the Fairhaven Trophies, shall be decided on the last 18, 9, 6, 3, 1 hole(s) in that order. If a tie still arises, it shall be decided by reference to each individual hole on the first 9 holes of that round commencing at the first. If a tie still arises, each of the preceding rounds played shall be treated in the same way (taking each round in the reverse order to that in which they were played) until a decision is reached.

Conditions of Play and Qualification

The Fairhaven Trophies & Nations Cup, is open to Amateur Golfers of all Nations

1. Conditions of Play

- a) The Fairhaven Trophies shall be played by Stroke Play over 72 holes over three (3) days, 18 holes being played on each of the first two days. After 36 holes, the leading 40 competitors and all those tied for 40th place shall play a further 36 holes on the 3rd day (a 2-tee start may be used if qualifiers exceed 48). As the LGU par is higher than the Men's par, the method employed to determine the leading 40 competitors will be the competitors 36 hole score against the par of the course they have played. Furthermore, a minimum of 6 girls will qualify for the final 36 holes.
- b) The winners shall be those competitors who return the lowest score over 72 holes. In the event of ties, a 'sudden death' play-off will be played over the 1st, 17th and 18th holes, until a player scores lower than the other player(s).
- c) Caddies must be under the age of 18 at 00:00hrs on 1st January in the year in which the Championship is to be played. *Penalty for breach of condition c): Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred. Maximum of four strokes per round.*
- d) The Fairhaven Trophy Nations Cup shall be played by Stroke Play over the first 36 holes, 2 scores to count for the team result.
 - i. Each Union/Federation may enter up to 2 teams, consisting of up to 3 players of which no more than 2 can be of the same gender, subject to fulfilling entry qualifications to the Fairhaven Trophies. Entry Fee per team - £30.
 - ii. In the event of a tie, the winner shall be decided in a similar manner to that detailed in section 10 of the General Conditions Relating to the Championship using the aggregate of the two counting scores of the team.
 - iii. The names of the team and its members are to be made known to the Championship Committee before the commencement of play. Substitutions may be made, provided the replacement fulfils all the age and handicap requirements, at the discretion of the Championship Committee. Any such replacement will take the starting time of the Player he/she is replacing. (There will be NO exception to this condition).

2. Prizes and Vouchers

- a) The Fairhaven Trophies - awarded to the boy and girl winners of the competition, each of whom will receive a commemorative silver medal.
- b) Prize vouchers shall be given for leading places, the value of which will be determined by the Championship Committee.
- c) The Fairhaven Trophy Nations Cup - the members of the winning team shall each receive a commemorative medal.

3. Qualification to play

- a) To be eligible to enter:
 - i. A boy must be in possession of a playing handicap not exceeding 3, under the current CONGU Unified Handicapping System or a comparable scheme operated by a recognised Overseas Golfing Union, Federation or Association.
 - ii. A girl must be in possession of a playing handicap not exceeding 6, under the current CONGU Unified Handicapping System or a comparable scheme operated by a recognised Overseas Golfing Union, Federation or Association.
 - iii. Under the age of 18 at 00:00hrs on the 1st January in the year in which the Championship is to be played.

4. Entries

Entries must be made on the entry form specified by the Championship Committee. In the case of a person who is a member of a Golf Club in Great Britain & Ireland, the 'Playing Handicap Certificate' must be signed by the Secretary of Handicapping Authority of their home club. An overseas player must enter through the Secretary of the recognised National Authority controlling golf in the country from which they wish to enter.

5. Closing Date

The Entry Form and entrance fee of £30 must be received by the Championship Committee, Fairhaven Golf Club, Oakwood Avenue, Lytham St Annes, Lancashire, FY8 4JU, England, not later than 5pm Monday 12th April 2010.

6. Ballot

Where the entries exceed 132 in number, there will be a ballot amongst the higher handicaps to reduce the entries to that number. Players eliminated by ballot will be kept on a reserve list. In the event of balloted players not filling any vacant places, entry fees will be returned. There will be places reserved for at least 30 girls.

7. Exemption from Ballot

A blank entry will be made for any boy who finishes in the top six (6) places in the McEvoy Trophy preceding this championship and for nominated 'Nations Cup' players.

8. Practice Day

Practice day for competitors will be Thursday 29th April 2010. Any additional rounds will be on payment of a £55 green fee.
