We are emailing you on behalf of the University of Warwick Golf Club (UWGC). We are looking to expand our BUCS (British University & Colleges Sport) squad of golfers with a handicap of 4 and below.

We believe UWGC offers a good balance of both competitive and social golf, coupled with excellent degree and career prospects from the University. The University has recently been ranked in the Top 10 British Universities for 2010 in the Times Good University Guide. Golfing highlights include Individual BUCS Order of Merit events throughout the year, being held at celebrated courses such as Princes and Woodhall Spa. Along side the Individual events, those in the golf team will have the chance to play at St Andrews in the Boyd Quaich trophy as well as the world Student Matchplay championships held annually in Munich.

We believe UWGC provides an excellent basis for talented golfers to continue and further their abilities whilst at the same time allowing them to pursue their academic studies. As a member of the Golf Club you are entitled to discounted membership of Kenilworth Golf Club for only £90, unlimited use of the practice facilities and two range trips a week. You are also eligible for support from the University Sport Department with Bursaries to aid your development as a player.

The main focus of the Golfing season is competing in the BUCS Leagues against other Universities of a similar high standard. We have had fixtures against Birmingham, Loughborough and Lincoln this year who have provided a high level of competition.

In the squad of 20 this year we have people studying a wide range of degrees including; Engineering, Law, Politics, Maths and Economics.

If any of your golfers are considering going to university we would ask you to pass this message onto them. We believe that the University of Warwick offers a high quality degree whilst offering a high standard of competitive golf.
